President's Report

Year ending Jan 31, 2014

Its been a mixed year for our replica project in that while we lost access to our previous hangar space last fall we've attracted the interest of additional volunteers: a draftsman, a second mechanical engineer, a pair of avionics techs, two apprenticing aircraft mechanics and more recently, a turbine engine specialist. This has allowed us to concentrate on some much needed design and engineering of the cockpit, avionics, retractable landing gear and primary flight control as well as simulator flight testing. While much time has been spent in the past year designing and building a wing test spar, we have yet to find a local facility with the ability to properly test it – we'll now build our own test rig.

While the project continues to flourish, the organization has admittedly met with a formidable challenge in finding new hangar space in which to continue major fabrication. Formidable, in that hangar space at Springbank Airport is rare, costly to rent and expensive to buy. Our reality is that the casino funding that supports our aircraft program cannot sustain the additional cost of hangar space - a separate hangar fund raising program will have to be undertaken. Other museums are now undertaking crowd funding for their major projects but research suggests that to be successful, public funding programs require a massive social media blitz prior to launch - please help us spread word of our project online.

To that end, a volunteer has posted a facebook page in our name to which we've contributed reports, photos and videos of our project – you can now show your friends and associates our project on https://www.facebook.com/AVROMuseum. This report and additional information can be found on our website at www.avromuseum.com.

To-date, we've spent some \$384,1910f the \$492,707funds raised on airframe fabrication supported by some 14,443 volunteer man hours valued at an additional \$360,825 and another \$132,675 in donated facilities, goods and services.

Our next Casino fund raising opportunity is scheduled for April 21-22, 2014 and our fund raising team could benefit from additional casino volunteers. Indeed, volunteers are needed for a whole range of other things as well – please check the website for ideas on how you might help us with a few hours of your time.

As we again move forward, the Board wishes to thank all our volunteers, Museum members and particularly our Casino volunteers, for their continued support.....



Notes to Financial Statements

1 - Purpose of the Organization

The A.V. Roe Canada Aviation Museum Association is a non-profit organization and registered charity, incorporated under the Societies Act of Alberta in 1997. The organization is dedicated to preserving the history of A.V. Roe Canada Ltd. through development of a Museum exhibit telling of the company's many accomplishments and the construction of a flying replica of the Avro Arrow aircraft.

2 - Significant Accounting Policies

- **Inventory** has been expensed out in detail expense accounts. Offset income accounts reflect the income from the small amount of inventory still carried.
- **Fixed assets** are expensed in the year of acquisition.
- **Revenue Recognition** contributions, including operating grants, are included in revenue in the year in which they are received or receivable, with the exception of contributions to fund specific future period operating expenses that are included in revenue in the later period.

3 - Cash – Designated

During any year the Association might raise funds through holding a Casino. These funds are held in a separate bank account and recorded as cash designated and net assets designated until they are spent for the purposes intended. Casino funds currently stand at \$105,977.89.

The casino funds are designated approximately for museum expenses, (15%), aircraft expenses (75%), and promotion expenses of the project (10%). The organization has approval from Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission to extend the disbursement of these funds in the following manner:

The amount of \$37,685.87 from the May 2011 casino pool distribution must be spent by June 30, 2014. The amount of \$68,292.02 from the September 2012 casino must be spent by November 30, 2014.

4 - Commitment

Avro Museum had a month-to-month shared rental agreement with Action Hobby for its administration office at \$304 per month (GST included). This agreement was terminated as of September 1, 2013. The space is now being donated by Action Hobby.
