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President's Report – 2012

Avro Museum is pleased to report the continued support of some thirty plus members in 2012. While work on our replica aircraft is being done quietly behind hangar doors, our efforts have now being filmed for a future TV news interest item.

In this past year we were successful in getting our replica design into a flight simulator to test aircraft handling in various flight scenarios. We're pleased to report that the aircraft in its original form truly flies well. We've also upgraded our aircraft structural and aerodynamic analysis software to the best industry standard to assist with design work.

Our focus of course remains one of design and fabrication and we've reached a critical point in our project - the design and development of capable wing spars and control systems.

Wing spars represent the most critical components of the airframe, they carry the weight of the aircraft in flight and the loads associated with landing. Much time has been spent in this past year on basic design, modeling, and repeated testing of materials and processes. Our sacrificial test spar is near complete and ready for destructive testing in late spring to prove its capability. Once testing has been completed, we will move on to building the seven spars that comprise the internal frame of the wing.

Members are encouraged to follow our progress as we continue to build a new website at a new address - www.avromuseum.com.

To-date, we've spent some \$322,187 of the \$474,173 funds raised on airframe fabrication supported by some 11,842 volunteer man hours valued at an additional \$296,050 along with \$111,800 in donated facilities, goods and services.

Our next Casino fund raising opportunity is scheduled for 2nd quarter of 2014 and our fund raising team could benefit from additional casino volunteers. Indeed, volunteers are needed for a whole range of other things as well – please check the website for ideas on how you might help us with a few hours of your time.

As we again move forward, the Board wishes to thank all our volunteers, Museum members and particularly our Casino volunteers, for their continued support.....

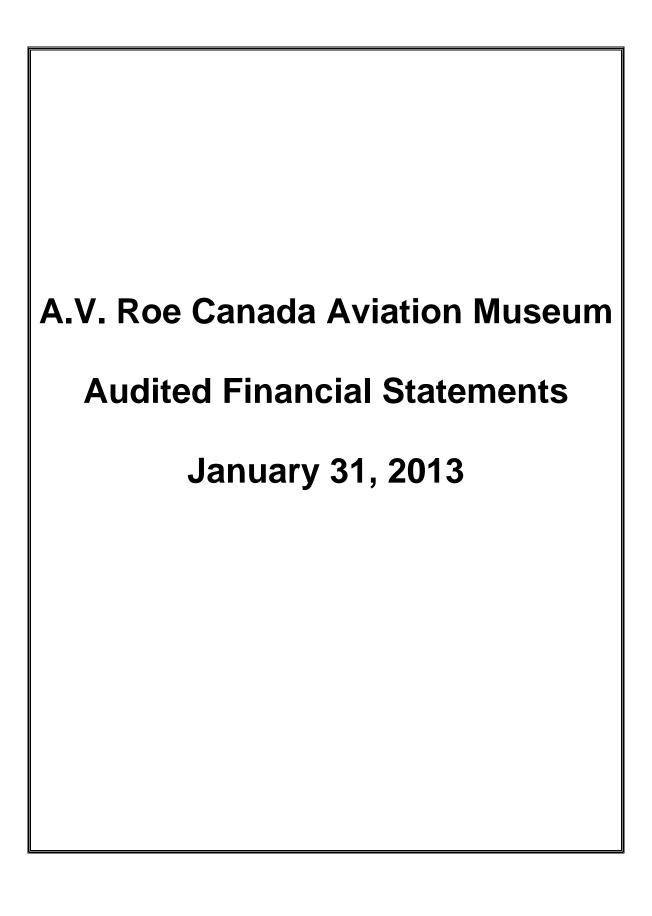

Notes to Financial Statements

1 - PURPOSE OF THE ORGANIZATION

The A.V. Roe Canada Aviation Museum Association is a non-profit organization and registered charity, incorporated under the Societies Act of Alberta in 1997. The organization is dedicated to preserving the history of A.V. Roe Canada Ltd. through development of a Museum exhibit telling of the company's many accomplishments and the construction of a flying replica of the Avro Arrow aircraft.

2 - Significant Accounting Policies

- Inventory has been expensed out in detail expense accounts. Offset income accounts reflect the income from the small amount of inventory still carried.
- **Fixed assets** are expensed in the year of acquisition.
- **Revenue Recognition** contributions, including operating grants, are included in revenue in the year in which they are received or receivable, with the exception of contributions to fund specific future period operating expenses that are included in revenue in the later period.

3 - Cash - Designated

During any year the Association might raise funds through holding a Casino. These funds are held in a separate bank account and recorded as cash designated and net assets designated until they are spent for the purposes intended. Casino funds currently stand at \$151,985.85.

The casino funds are designated approximately for museum expenses, (15%), aircraft expenses (75%), and promotion expenses of the project (10%). The organization has approval from Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission to extend the disbursement of these funds in the following manner:

The amount of \$17,028.83 from the November 2009 casino pool distribution must be spent by February 28, 2013. The amount of \$66,665.00 from the May 2011 casino must be spent by August 31, 2013. The amount of \$68,292.02 from the September 2012 casino must be spent by November 30, 2014.

4 - Commitment

Avro Museum has a month-to-month shared rental agreement with Action Hobby for its administration office at \$304 per month (GST included).
